

Cricket Equipment and Clothing Guidelines (Covid-19 Policy)

With the current global situation, we must look to see how we all can ensure the health and safety procedures set out by the Government and ECB are adhered to by all players, parents, and staff.

Please take a minute to read through some important Player Guidelines suggested by City Cricket Academy. It is very important that young cricketers have the right equipment during their training and matches to learn and develop while ensuring they stay safe.

- **Cricket Kit** including, Helmet, Pads, Gloves, Bat, Thigh Pads, Box all must be of correct sizes. Players wearing smaller/ larger equipment than needed, can lead serious injuries
- **Correct Footwear** is a must and also must be of correct size to ensure ankle stability and support for players. If footwear is too small or too big this can lead to serious injuries from the waist down. **White based Running** trainers are strongly advised.
- **Kit Hygiene** must be looked after, ensuring kit is kept clean and dry after use. Products such as **Spray Wear** or other antiseptic sprays which disinfects and keeps kit clean and fresh is highly recommended.
- **Hand Sanitisers.** We strongly advise players to bring their own hand sanitiser and regularly sanitise their hands after using equipment.
- **Antiperspirant Spray.** Use of antiperspirant spray is advised to reduce sweat.
- **Hand Towel.** We strongly advise all players have a clean hand towel at every session to wipe away sweat during training.

Please take a minute to read through some important Parent/Guardian Guidelines suggested by City Cricket Academy.

It is very important that parents/ guardians also follow similar rules to help CCA ensure the facility is kept clean and social distancing measures are adhered to. We suggest where possible for parents to remain 2 metres apart from all players and staff not within your social bubble.

- **Seating Area.** Our seating area is open, and guidelines have been laid to ensure parents stay socially distanced, however we suggest if and where possible to drop off players and pick up players from outside the facility.
- Ensure cricketers follow the guidelines mentioned above
- **Payments.** Made via Card or Bank Transfer where possible. We suggest if there are payments to be made at the desk, parents wait for the session to start before proceeding to the Reception desk to ensure the reception area is kept clear of traffic.
